We just want to give you a heads up on the Barcardi sponsored 2008 Bermuda International Race Week to be held April 26 – May 2, 2008 (no sailing April 30) in the local waters of Bermuda.

We will shortly be putting up a website which will initially cover things such as logistical items (shipping costs, boat splashing, rig set up, accommodation, social programme, hospitality, how to get rid of a dark and stormy hangover, etc.).

The objective will be to make this Regatta as user friendly as possible. We will work with YOU and the race committee as to the specific dates we sail, the number of races, type of races, etc. We have a number of interested boats from away but for us to benefit from group shipping, we are looking ideally for a min of 6 away boats.

Rather than shipping your 105 up the East Coast after Key West, have it sent to Bermuda for our race week. Afterwards it can either be shipped back to Florida or on to New Jersey for the spring/summer sailing season.

More details will be coming out but as many of you are planning 2008 now, Bermuda International Race Week should be on your calendar.
