

**NOTICE TO J/105 SAILMAKERS**

---

**Effective 2/15/2002:**

1. Windows are permitted in the mainsail.
2. The three rollable battens in the jib may be any length and any orientation and need not be equally spaced as in the past. Jibs may have windows.  
NOTE: There will be a technical committee interpretation stating that battens MAY NOT extend from the leech to the foot OR beyond the line between the clew and the tack.

**Effective 7/1/2002:**

1. The language of the sail rules will be made compatible with the ISAF Equipment Rules of Sailing. To keep the jibs the same dimensions with the new measurement technique, the jib half-width has been reduced by 110 mm.
2. The jib weight will be controlled by a "bag weight" of 23 pounds rather than a cloth weight of 6 oz. There's a new head width maximum of 80 mm.

**Effective 1/1/2003:**

1. The class spinnaker becomes the 89 m<sup>2</sup> spinnaker with new luff maximum of 15100 mm and leech maximum of 12140 mm. (This was previously announced.)
